### HOW WE USE COOKIES

When we provide services, we want to make them easy, useful and reliable. Where services are delivered on the internet, this sometimes involves placing small amounts of information on your device, for example, computer or mobile phone. These include small files known as cookies. They cannot be used to identify you personally.

These pieces of information are used to improve services for you through, for example:

- enabling a service to recognise your device so you don't have to give the same information several times during one task;
- recognising that you may already have given a username and password so you don't need to do it for every web page requested;
- measuring how many people are using services, so they can be made easier to use and there is enough capacity to ensure they are fast.

### OUR USE OF COOKIES

#### 1. COOKIES FOR MANAGING CURRENT VISIT

Name: site\_session

Typical Content: randomly generated text

Expires: when user exits browsers

#### 2. COOKIES FOR IMPROVING SERVICE

Name: \_utma

Typical Content: randomly generated text

Expires: 2 years

Name: \_utmb

Typical Content: randomly generated text

Expires: 30min

Name: \_utmc

Typical Content: randomly generated text

Expires: when user exits browser

Name: \_utmz

Typical Content: randomly generated number + information on how the site was reached (e.g. directly via a link, organic search or paid search)

Expires: 6 months
